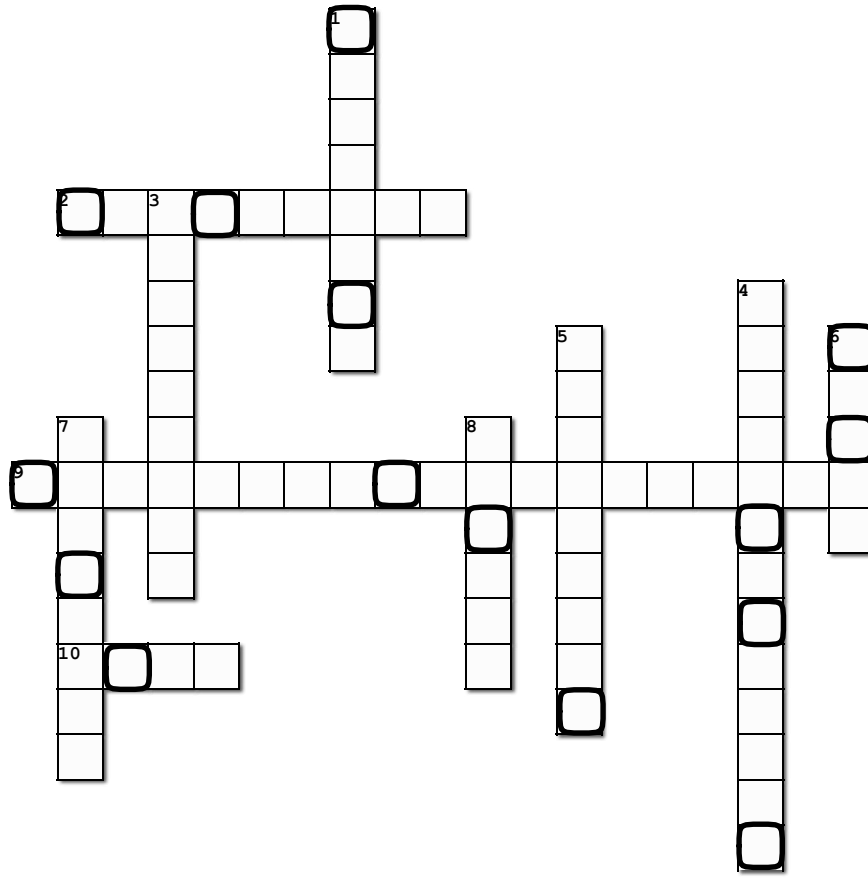


Gallants Channel
